Subject: 12.10b Public Safety Car in Lake Incident

Dear Ms. Griffin:

Mr. Ray Ammarell's September 28, 2024, submittal reported a 12.10b project related public safety incident at the Saluda Project No. 516. The incident involved a single vehicle accident that resulted in a fatality and a car entering Lake Murray via South Carolina Highway 6 and the Original Dam Embankment. Mr. Ammarell provided an initial notification of the incident on September 13, 2024, via phone call and email.

We have completed our review and found your report and initial notification satisfy the Commission's 18 CFR § 12.10 reporting requirements. We agree with your determination that this incident was related to a project structure but not related to project operations. Therefore, no additional public safety measures are warranted at this time to avoid or reduce the chance of similar occurrence in the future.
